Please be advised that Scholarship applications will be made available to our members dependent children who will be graduating from high school in the Spring of 2012 and intend to enter college in September 2012. The forms for these scholarships will be available at the Trust Fund Office, during the month of September 2011, or you may call (212) 535-2323 and ask Carol Stephenson to mail the forms to your home.

The following scholarship Application will be available to dependents of active, retired or deceased members:

■ The Walter Matthews/John Sheehan Scholarship (sponsored by Local 46) – available in the month of September 2011. The value is \$3,000.00 per year for 4 years. The rules for this scholarship is:

-Eligibility for this scholarship is a child, stepchild, adopted child or foster child, living with or being supported by an employee, pensioner (living or deceased) who has accumulated at least 10 years of pension credits (of which at least one (1) shall have been earned in the two (2) calendar years preceding the application or in the year of the application) under the rules of the Pension Fund Metal Lathers Local 46, or in the case of a deceased employee, who had accumulated these pension credits at the time of his death.

The following scholarship applications are available to the legal dependents of Local 46 members in good standing who are graduating from High School in the Spring of 2012:

■The John Tierney Scholarship (sponsored by Reynolds Family) – available in the month of September 2011. The value is \$3,000.00 per year for 4 years.

■The Ira Sacks/Bill Cashman Scholarship (sponsored by Sacks & Sacks) – available in the month of September 2011. The value to be announced.

■The Building Industry Scholarship Program (sponsored by the BCA – available in the months of September/October 2011). The value is \$2,000.00 per year for 4 years.

■The John H. Lyons, Sr. Scholarship (sponsored by the Ironworkers International).


