HOW TO PROCEED

SAT: Reasoning Test and SAT Subject Tests (SAT®)

Register for and take The College Board's SAT® no later than the December administration. When completing the Reports to Colleges and Scholarship Sponsors Section of your Registration form, enter Code 0526 for the Walter M. Matthews and John M. Sheehan Metal Lathers Local 46 Scholarship Program as one of the colleges or scholarship programs to which scores are to be sent. NOTE: If this instruction is not followed accurately, the scores will not be reported and you will be declared ineligible.

To register for the October 1, 2011 or November 5, 2011 SAT, you will need a copy of the College Board SAT Registration Bulletin. If not available from your high school, you may obtain one online by contacting The College Board at: www.CollegeBoard.com.

Obtain the Registration Bulletin early because there are registration deadlines. Walk-in registration or Standby Testing—which carries a fee of \$36.00—may be available at the Test Center, but it is not guaranteed.

Students who have taken the SAT at an earlier time are not required to take the test again. In order to have scores from an earlier administration of the SAT reported, submit an Additional Report Request Form available at your high school. Fill in the Code Number 0526 for Walter M. Matthews and John M. Sheehan Metal Lathers Local 46 Scholarship Program and send the form with the appropriate fee before November 28, 2011 to The College Board SAT Program according to the instructions in the Registration Bulletin.

NOTE: Only SAT scores are acceptable. Since test scores are used in the selection procedure, all scholarship applicants are required to submit SAT scores. Without scores, it will be necessary to disqualify the applicant.

September

Applications may be obtained by those eligible from the Fund Office, 260 East 78th Street, New York, N.Y. 10075 (212-535-2323). Completed Scholarship Applications must be returned to Scholarship & Recognition Programs, PO Box 6730, Princeton, NJ 08541 no later than November 27, 2011. **Do not return this application to the Fund Office.**

NOTE: Scholarship & Recognition Programs (SRP) will not acknowledge receipt of this application. However, all applicants will be notified of the outcome of their participation in the competition. **If you do not receive correspondence from SRP by early February, call the Contact Center immediately at 609-771-7878 where the Customer Service Representatives are willing to help you with your questions/concerns.**

October/November/December

Applicants may take SAT test. (see above)

January

Semi-finalists identified on the basis of SAT Reasoning Test scores and junior year rank-in-class. SRP sends Scholarship Questionnaire, with instructions to semi-finalists.

February

Scholarship Questionnaires, Letters of Recommendation and high school transcripts must be postmarked by February 26, 2012 to SRP.

March

Scholarship Review Committee meets to select finalists

April/May

SRP notifies winners

Selection of Winners

As an applicant, you should be informed that your test scores* are used to determine the top 40 candidates in the scholarship competition. These candidates are designated as semi-finalists and are requested to provide the scholarship selection committee with additional data.

The winners are selected by an independent committee whose training and experience qualify it to evaluate total high school records, including academic work, test scores, extracurricular activities, leadership qualities, high school recommendations, and the student's own statements. This committee meets early 2012 to review the credentials of all semi-finalists. Each folder is reviewed by two members of the committee and rated according to the standards established by SRP. Each candidate is then ranked according to the committee's review. The first ten candidates are identified as winners, the next five candidates are identified as alternates. If for some reason a candidate identified as a winner does not accept the award, the first alternate would then be offered the award. If necessary, this procedure would take place down the line of alternates. Each candidate must be willing to accept the Scholarship Committee decision as final.
